BUTTONS ON A PILLOW

WHAT YOU NEED

- Pillow, preferably with a zip-off or unbutton cover
- Thread, matching the pillow or buttons, or contrasting purposefully
- Needle (if your pillow cover does not come off, use a curved needle)
- Buttons. This project required 80 matching buttons. (You might plan a different design, requiring more or less buttons or those that vary in size, shape and color.)
- Pencil or seamstress chalk

PREPARATION

1. If you can, remove the pillow cover from the filling. If you cannot remove the cover, use a curved needle to easily sew on your buttons.
2. Laying the cover on a flat surface, place your buttons until you have a pleasing color and surface arrangement.
3. Using a pencil or sewing chalk, mark the placement of your buttons.
4. Thread your needle and sew them on!
5. Enjoy your very unique, very personal pillow!
6. Turn the pillow case inside out before washing.
